

VARSIY GIRLS SUMMER LEAGUE RULES

- All teams must designate a Team Representative, all players play at their own risk.
- All high school players must be age appropriate and enrolled at participating school. Players should be able to provide any necessary information!
- Each team must supply a linesman every game.
- **45 Minute Games (no halftime)** - running time will only be stopped for serious injury or delay of game in the final minutes.

Regular rules apply except:

- 7 field players and a goalie
- NO offside's
- Substitution "on the fly" (player must be within 5 yds of bench and player entering the field must enter from the bench)
- GOALKEEPER CANNOT PICK UP BALL ON PASS BACK OR THROW IN!
- NO PUNTING
- NO slide tackling (*indirect kick*)
- Goal kicks or keeper throw cannot cross midfield on the fly (*must bounce or be touched, indirect for other team at midfield*)
- Goal kicks are put directly into play. Defensive team players must give 10 yards until ball is played.
- 8 a side - 6 players to start. **Clock will be started by Ref on time.** After a 10 minute lapse the game will be considered a forfeit (forfeit wins are recorded as 2-0). If less than 33 minutes remain teams may play, but it will be official only if both teams agree prior.
- **SHINGUARDS ARE MANDATORY**
- Players cannot play for two teams in the same league. Teams may forfeit if an illegal player is used, WITHOUT the consent of the opposing team
- Two points for a win; one point for a tie; (no overtime).
- Tie Breakers: 1-head to head, 2-goal differential, 3-goals against, 4-goals scored
- Team Reps must ensure all team participants sign the 2010 Waiver Form
- All spectators must be behind the fence

RED CARD EJECTION

- One game suspension
- Two red cards to the same player - ejection from the league.
- Ejection for FIGHTING will result in suspension from league

ALL DECISIONS by Staff are final and will be made in the best interest of the league.

There will be a league representative each night games are played. Any major problems that require staff decisions will be resolved by Monday of the following week.

TEAMS MUST BE PREPARED TO START ON TIME!!!!

There is space around the field to warm up, so when the previous game is over we will immediately begin the next one - the referee will start the clock
