  - □ Academic standards
  - □ Student assessment
  - □ Sources of information other than web

## Parent Checklist Rubric:

- □ Based on current research
- Contents of Checklist include tips for strengthening-
  - Child's academic progress (with emphasis on reading)
  - Citizenship/social skills/respectfulness (character ed elements)
  - Communication between school and home
- □ Checklist was sent home to all parents

## Reporting to the DOE:

- Assurance that above criteria were met
  - Compliance with other areas of the Act including-
    - Specific parents are notified in K-7 of their child's reading deficiency
    - Staff development topic include working effectively with parents
    - Parent involvement is a focus in district's inservice activities
    - Technical assistance was received by district staff from the DOE
