

6th Grade Supply List

Supplies are due the first day of school. You are responsible for being prepared every day. This list should be attached into your planner on the first day of school so you have it as a reference throughout the year.

Do not wait until September to buy your supplies. It is a good idea to shop in July/August when there are sales and supplies are easily available. You do not have to buy name brands.

7 Bound composition notebooks - No spiral notebooks or binders.

1 Package of Post-It notes (any brand!)

At least 6 pencils - no mechanical pencils

At least 3 pens - blue or black ink only

Pencil sharpener

Small stapler with a package of staples

Eraser

Pencil case - no pencil boxes (they will not fit inside your desks)

Small bottle of glue

1 Pair of scissors

1 Ruler with metric and customary units

1 Box of crayons - pack of 8 is fine

2 Rolls of tape

5 Folders with pockets

3 Book Socks (large or extra-large) or 3 Book Covers

2 Highlighters

Headphones
