High School Academies, Dual Enrollment and Associate Program

Mr. Pinto and his high school administrative team are excited to introduce to three (3) new high school academy programs for our incoming grade 9 students. The academies are STEM, Culinary Arts and Humanities. Please follow the link below for more information;

These new and exciting programs will give students the opportunity to concentrate in these academic areas during their high school career.

High school juniors and seniors are also eligible for Dual Enrollment courses through Bergen Community College. Students who successfully complete the requirements of these courses will receive college credit that can be applied to college upon graduation from high school.

The new Associate's Program will allow juniors to take college credits at CPHS and BCC over a two-year period. If successful, at the end of their senior year, students will receive both a high school diploma as well as an Associate's degree from BCC allowing them to enter their junior year of college.

School 3 Expansion is Underway

Construction is underway for the installation of 12 new modular classrooms at School #3. These classrooms will allow us to accommodate our growing student population. Completion date is scheduled for August 2019.

District Reorganization

Parents of students currently in Grades PreK and 4 & 5 in School 5, Kindergarten and Grade 5 in School 4, Grades 4 & 5 in School 3 and Grades 1, 2, & 3 in School 6 were mailed letters in January notifying parents of school assignments for September 2019.
