WEEK of AUGUST 2

Sign Language (Fee: \$50)

This course will introduce the fundamental elements of American Sign Language. Emphasis will be based on the development of basic expressive & receptive skills.

WEEK of AUGUST 9

Science Experiments (Fee: \$50)

Join us on an exciting adventure creating glop and other fascinating scientific concoctions! Students will discover the secrets of kitchen science, light, physics and more by experimenting with various materials and finding out how things work. Students will conduct and observe experiments, investigate reactions, create scientific projects and learn how science is all around us.

Ceramics (Fee: \$50)

Students will learn about ceramic building. They will create pots, plates, tiles and figurines using different ceramic techniques. Each student will complete at least one ceramic project to take home. Students taking Advanced Ceramics will create more complex pieces.

Microbiology (Fee: \$50)

Students will learn the basics of electron microscopy, how to use a light microscope, and how to differentiate healthy tissues from diseased tissues. Students will also learn how to culture microorganisms and prepare microscopic slides.
